Technical notes

- Direction of flow is outside to inside through the element.
- Filter elements should be replaced at least every 6 months.
- Differential pressure gauges (65DPG250B) are fitted to all models as standard. Volt free contact options are available - see price guide.
- Manual drain valves (MDVE25) are fitted to all models. Sterilizable glass drain flasks are supplied as standard, 100ml for models A3052MV to A3101MV and 250ml for models A3102MV to A3303MV.
- Threaded connections are NPT to ANSI/ASME B1.20.1.
